

【Confucius Institute Scholarship】

The Confucian Institute Scholarship Program was established by Hanban/Confucius Institute Headquarters in order to promote the sustainable development of international Chinese studies. Beijing International Studies University accepts the scholarship winners as its general advanced students.

Eligibility :

- 1) Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens who are in the age bracket of 16-35 with good health;
- 2) Applicants must offer the degree certificates of new HSK and meet the scholarship requirements.

Note:

Students cannot apply the Confucian Institute Scholarship if they have received funding from the Chinese government or/and any other organizations.

Applicants, who are less than 18 years old, are required to submit the relevant legal documents of their legal guardians in China.

Scholarship Coverage and Criteria :

- 1) Exempt from registration fee, tuition fee, fee for basic learning materials and accommodation fee for dormitory on campus;
- 2) Monthly allowances (CNY Yuan/Month):
Advanced study: CNY 1,400 Yuan
Postgraduate study: CNY 1,700 Yuan
- 3) One settlement subsidy, at the following rates (CNY Yuan):
Students who will study in China for one academic year or more: CNY 1,500 Yuan;
Students who will study in China for one semester: CNY 1,000 Yuan;
Students who have studied in China before the admission: No one settlement subsidy;
- 4) Fee for outpatient medical service, and Comprehensive Medical Insurance and Protection Program for International Students in China

Ways to Apply :

General advanced students (one-year or one-semester) :

- 1) The Confucius Institutes worldwide will recommend outstanding students and submit the applications to BISU;
- 2) The winners of “Chinese Bridge” Chinese Proficiency Competitions can directly submit applications to BISU

Application Deadline and Materials : Refer to the notice of application year

Application and Evaluation :

- 1) Scholarship winners must register at the university before the deadline set by the admission notice. Scholarships will not be kept for those who do not register on time;
- 2) If the physical examinations of scholarship winners are unqualified, their scholarship qualifications will be withdrawn;
- 3) According to *Appraisal Procedures for Confucius Institute Scholarship*, the scholarship students who have been studying for more than one year will be evaluated to determine whether they will continue to enjoy the scholarship for the following academic year.
